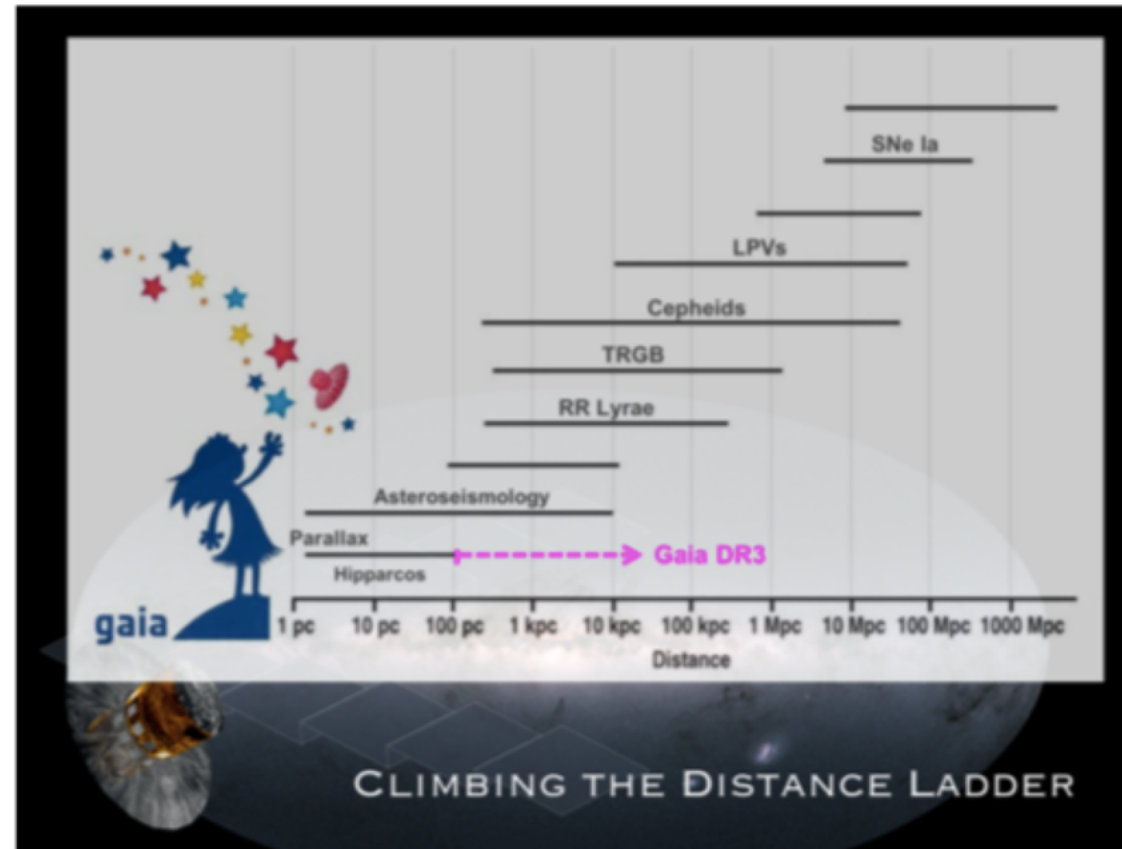

Eligible young scientists should be not older than 2 years after the PhD degree at the time of his/her nomination by the leader. The Leader, in consultation with the other members of the Team, is expected to identify the young scientists and establish a programme. Young scientists may, attend all meetings of a Team but could also vary among them.

ISSI support for the young scientists will consist of the **accommodation** and of a **per diem** to cover the meals while in Bern, as for the core team members (no travel). The additional support allocated to a Team for young scientists, will be about 20% of the total core Team members.
